ALL BEGINNERS CONCERT BAND SYLLABUS

The All Beginners Concert Band, directed by Geeta Das, is the first step to introducing (or re-introducing) yourself to the wide and wonderful world of music! Whether you used to play an instrument in school, would like to switch instruments, or have never had any exposure to music whatsoever, this is the ensemble for you. Starting from the very beginning of the musical journey, this class serves as a condensed introduction to everything you need to know in order to become a spectacular musician within a concert band.

In this course you will learn all of the primary elements of music making including reading music, instrument techniques, musical concepts such as rhythm, dynamics and style, music appreciation and exploration (history) and basic music theory. No prior knowledge of music is required. A successful, entertaining learning experience is guaranteed!

This is a condensed course, during which time you will experience an average of 1 year's worth of typical music education in a shortened span. A great deal of material is covered each week. Therefore, it is highly recommended that all students attend on a weekly basis. At the end of the course, the ABC band merges with the Intermediate Concert Band in order to continue their exponential growth with fellow mentors in the larger concert band.
