Before Day of Rehearsal Protocol:

- Members must register on line per session if they are attending and confirm that that are not sick.
- There will be an emphasis on health; do not come to rehearsal if you are not well. Wash or sanitize your hands.
- A reminder on how to cough/sneeze safely.
- A reminder on how to properly clean wind instruments.
- A reminder to bring a mask, hand sanitizer, sanitizing solution (unscented or low scent) and cloth to wipe down chairs and music stands, towel or puppy pad with germ killing solution (unscented or low scent).

Day of Rehearsal Protocol:

- There will be an emphasis on health; do not come to rehearsal if you are not well. Wash or sanitize your hands.
- A reminder on how to cough/sneeze safely.
- Bring own music stand (if one can) and own sheet music (mandatory) .
- Bring pop screens or bell covers .
- · Do not share sheet music .
- Bring towel or puppy pad with germ killing solution(unscented or low secent).
- Bring sanitizing solution and cloth to wipe down chairs and music stands.(unscented or low scent)
- Bring a mask .
- M.R.C.B. designate(s) arrive early to set up the rehearsal space. This will reduce or eliminate congestion of members arriving and setting up all at the same time prior to rehearsal. One designate should also have a spare bottle of hand sanitizer in the event that a member forgets their own.

Before entering Rehearsal Space Protocol:

- Do not arrive earlier than 15 minutes before rehearsal is scheduled to begin. Maintain six foot distance while waiting to get in the rehearsal space.
- List of registered members for that session will be used as attendance and for contact information. Health check upon entering with temperature check and asking if they are well. Administered by M.R.C.B. designate(s).

- Wearing of masks mandatory before entering and left on until conductor says ready to play.
- Members must sanitize their hands before entering the rehearsal space.

During Rehearsal Protocol:

- Distance between musicians / conductor will be a minimum of 2 meters.
 This may be adjusted according to section and instruments and based on best/safest practice.
- No playing instruments until everyone is seated and ready to play.
- · Wearing of masks mandatory when seated before playing .
- Conductors to wear a mask or face shield.
- Percussionists must wear a mask.
- Shorter rehearsals (no longer than 60 minutes) .
- All woodwind and brass players must have a towel or a puppy pad with germ killing solution(unscented or low scent) to manage condensation or spit.

Break from Rehearsal Protocol (assuming there are breaks):

- · Wearing of masks mandatory when not seated to play.
- Fans or other source of ventilation increased during the break. 10-15 minute break.
- Musicians will use their puppy pads or cloths(with disinfectant solution unscented or low scent) to clear (not clean) their instruments.

Before exiting Rehearsal Space Protocol- end of rehearsal:

- Wearing of masks mandatory.
- Chairs and music stands to be sanitized by each musician. M.R.C.B. designate(s) will put the chairs and stands away.
- Cleaning of instruments is not permitted in the rehearsal space. Instruments must be put away as is and cleaned at home or outside the building.

After Rehearsal Protocol:

• Should any musician become sick showing Covid19 symptoms, all attendees, executive, conductors, S/D 42 designate or other facility designate will be notified. The list of attendees will be taken from the master list confirmed at the beginning of the rehearsal.
